

## Knowledge

*de a* – knowledge garnered by the senses (f). There are only a few masculine uses- translated as “opinion.” Derivative of *yada*; description of familiar spirit is drawn from this root.

### The Lord is a God of Knowledge

#### 1 Samuel 2:2-4

<sup>2</sup> *There is* none holy as the LORD: for *there is* none beside thee: neither *is there* any rock like our God. <sup>3</sup> Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let *not* arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD *is* a God of **knowledge**, and by him actions are weighed. <sup>4</sup> The bows of the mighty men *are* broken, and they that stumbled are girded with strength.

### Who Will Be Taught?

#### Isaiah 28:9-12

<sup>9</sup> Whom shall he teach **knowledge**? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine (*bin shemua a*)? *them that are* weaned from the milk, *and* drawn from the breasts. <sup>10</sup> For precept *must be* upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, *and* there a little: <sup>11</sup> For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people. <sup>12</sup> To whom he said, This *is* the rest (*menuha*) wherewith ye may cause the weary to rest (*nuah*); and this *is* the refreshing (repose after a sifting/shaking): yet they would not hear.

### Pastors

**Jeremiah 3:15** And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with **knowledge** and understanding (circumspect intelligence and progression of thought).

### Objective

#### Isaiah 11:9

<sup>9</sup> They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the **knowledge** of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.

### Seven Spirits? Or, the Thee-fold Counsel of the Spirit of the Lord?

#### Isaiah 11:1-3

<sup>1</sup> And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots: <sup>2</sup> And the spirit of the LORD shall rest (*nuah*) upon him, the spirit of wisdom (skill...even wit) and understanding (*bina*), the spirit of counsel (advice, a plan) and might (*gebura*), the spirit of knowledge (to be aware, and can dissect the nuts and bolts) and of the fear of the LORD; <sup>3</sup> And shall make him of quick understanding (*ruah*) in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears:
