Acts 18:18

¹⁸ And Paul *after this* tarried *there* yet a good while, and then took his leave of the brethren, and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn *his* head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow (*euche*).

James 5:14,15

¹⁴ Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray (*proseuchomai*) over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:¹⁵ And the prayer (*euche*) of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

²⁹ Then fearing lest we should have fallen upon rocks, they cast four anchors out of the stern, and wished (*euchomai*) for the day.
