

## The Calves of our Lips

### Psalm 65:1-5

<sup>1</sup> Praise (*tehillah*) waiteth (silent, dumb) for thee, O God, in Sion: and unto thee shall the vow (see N.T. *euchoe*) be **performed** (*shalem*). <sup>2</sup> O thou that hearest prayer (*tephillah*), unto thee shall all flesh come. <sup>3</sup> Iniquities prevail against me: *as for* our transgressions, thou shalt purge them away. <sup>4</sup> Blessed *is the man whom* thou chooseth, and causeth to approach *unto thee, that* he may dwell in thy courts: we shall be satisfied with the goodness of thy house, *even* of thy holy temple. <sup>5</sup> *By* terrible things in righteousness wilt thou answer us, O God of our salvation; *who art* the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of them that are afar off *upon* the sea: (and vv.9-11)

***shalem* – to fulfill, to recompense or restore according to your pledge**

### Ecclesiastes 5:4-8

<sup>4</sup> When thou vowest a vow unto God, defer not to **pay** it; for *he hath* no pleasure in fools: **pay** that which thou hast vowed. <sup>5</sup> Better *is it* that thou shouldest not vow, than that thou shouldest vow and not **pay**. <sup>6</sup> Suffer not thy mouth to cause thy flesh to sin; neither say thou before the angel, that it *was* an error: wherefore should God be angry at thy voice, and destroy the work of thine hands? <sup>7</sup> For in the multitude of dreams and many words *there are* also *divers* vanities: but fear thou God. <sup>8</sup> If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for *he that is* higher than the highest regardeth; and *there be* higher than they.

### 1 Kings 7:51

<sup>51</sup> So was **ended** all the work that king Solomon made for the house of the LORD. And Solomon brought in the things which David his father had dedicated; *even* the silver, and the gold, and the vessels, did he put among the treasures of the house of the LORD.

### Hosea 14:1-2

<sup>1</sup> O Israel, return unto the LORD thy God; for thou hast fallen by thine iniquity. <sup>2</sup> Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto him, Take away all iniquity, and receive *us* graciously: so will we **render** the calves of our lips.

### **Joel 2:24-25**

<sup>24</sup> And the floors shall be full of wheat, and the fats shall overflow with wine and oil.

<sup>25</sup> And I will **restore** to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you.
