Initial Interpretation

Luke 1:30

And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour (*charis*) with God.

Further reflection upon meaning of the dream

KJV

A temporary departure from our normal measure of interpretation

Three Major themes of "favour" in the Bible

*hen* – grace – engaged in the new horizon, next measure of discovery in the divine time and plan

- Promotion, but beware its ambiance

Exodus 3:21

And I will give this people *favour* in the sight of the Egyptians: and it shall come to pass, that, when ye go, ye shall not go empty:

Proverbs 31:30

*Favour* is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that feareth the LORD, she shall be praised

- We must remain committed to our partnership with His purpose

Proverbs 3:3,4

Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart: 4 So shalt thou find *favour* and good (*towb*) understanding in the sight of God and man.

Proverbs 13:15

Good (*towb*) understanding giveth *favour*: but the way of transgressors is hard.

*towb* – the good and perfect will/purpose of God

I Samuel 2:26

And the child Samuel grew on, and was in *favour* both with the LORD, and also with men.

*raison* – fulfilment in each divine arrangement, and the pleasure/content/blessing attained from the fulfillment. (see also *hapes* -favoureth)

- Time and Year

Isaiah 49:8

Thus saith the LORD, In an **acceptable** time have I heard thee, and in a day of salvation have I helped thee:and I will preserve thee,and give thee for a covenant of the people,to establish the earth, to cause to inherit the desolate heritages;

Isaiah 60:10

And the sons of strangers shall build up thy walls, and their kings shall minister unto thee: for in my wrath I smote thee, but in my *favour* have I had mercy on thee.

Isaiah 61:2

To proclaim the **acceptable** year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

- Proper Perspective

Psalms 19:14

Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be **acceptable** in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.

- Preservation

Psalms 5:12

For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with *favour* wilt thou compass him as with a shield.

Psalms 30:5 - 8

For his anger endureth but a moment; in his *favour* is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning. And in my prosperity I said,I shall never be moved.LORD, by thy *favour* thou hast made my mountain to stand strong:thou didst hide thy face, and I was troubled.I cried to thee, O LORD;and unto the LORD I made supplication.
