

The Power of the Resurrection

anastasis – (n) – the establishment of something lasting, according to the foundational plan

*compare *egeiro* (rising to action)

and *anistemi* (v):

Mark 1:35 And in the morning, **rising up** a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed.

Mark 2:14 And as he passed by, he saw Levi the son of Alphaeus sitting at the receipt of custom, and said unto him, Follow me. And he **arose** and followed him.

Mark 10:50-52 50 And he, casting away his garment, **rose**, and came to Jesus. 51 And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? -- The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight. 52 And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.

Mark 3:26 And if Satan **rise up** against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end.

Mark 8:31 And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and of the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days **rise again**.

Mark 9:31 For he taught his disciples, and said unto them, -- The Son of man is delivered into the hands of men, and they shall kill him; and after that he is killed, he shall **rise** the third day.

Mark 16:9 Now when Jesus was **risen** early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.

1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall **rise** first (*proton*):

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The Son of God was, is and always will be the Resurrection

John 11:21-26 21 Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died. 22 But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee. 23 Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise (*anistemi*) again. 24 Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise (*anistemi*) again in the resurrection at the last day. 25 Jesus said unto her, I am the **resurrection**, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: 26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

Acts 26:23 That Christ should suffer, and that he should be the first (*protos*) that should **rise** from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles. (See also Rev.20:5-6)

Our “lively hope” and inheritance

1 Peter 1:1-10 1 Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to the strangers scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, 2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied. 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively (zoo) hope by the **resurrection** of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 To an inheritance incorruptible (does not wither away), and undefiled (does not become impure or spoiled), and that fadeth not away (no illusion), reserved (tereo) in heaven for you, 5 Who are kept (a watchman) by the power (d) of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed (*apokalypto*) in the last time. 6 Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations: 7 That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: 8 Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory: 9 Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls. 10 Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you:

The Power (*dunamis*)

- **According to the Spirit of holiness**

Romans 1:4 And declared to be the Son of God with power (d), according to the spirit of holiness, by the **resurrection** from the dead:

- **Great Power and Great Grace**

Acts 4:33 And with great power (*megas dunamis*) gave the apostles witness of the **resurrection** of the Lord Jesus: and great grace (*megas charis*) was upon them all.

- **Through Knowing Him**

Philippians 3:10 That I may know him, and the power (d) of his **resurrection**, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;
