A Reprobate Mind

Romans 1:16-32

[♪ Dependent on You- Jon Thurlow]

[16] For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

[17]For therein (the gospel of Christ) is the <u>righteousness of God revealed</u> from faith to faith: as it is written, the just shall live by faith. [18]For the <u>wrath of God is revealed from heaven</u> against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness;

[19]Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. [20]For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: [21] Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became <u>vain</u> in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

- Vain: Greek- ματαιόω
- Transliteration: mataioō To <u>passively</u> become foolish, and to allow oneself to become <u>morally wicked</u>.
- Specifically idolatrous.

[22]Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, [23] And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things. [24]Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonor their own bodies between themselves:

[25] Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. [26] For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: [27] And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompense of their error which was meet.

[28] And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a <u>reprobate</u> mind, to do those things which are not convenient;

- Gave- Greek: παραδίδωμι
- Transliteration: paradidōmi- To surrender, yield, give up, give something over to
- Reprobate- Greek: ἀδόκιμος
- Transliteration: adokimos- Rejected, Unapproved, Worthless, Castaway, that's the word reprobate

[29]Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, [30]Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, [31]Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural

affection, implacable, unmerciful: [32]Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

[1]Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. [2] But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.
