

## Praying with Pinpoint Purpose for the Pneumatikos People

- **Paul Commissioning the Saints to Prayer**

11 Corinthians 1:2-9 (KJV) 2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

3 Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ.

4 I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ;

5 That in every thing ye are enriched by him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge; 6 Even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you: 7 So that ye come behind in no gift; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ: 8 Who shall also confirm you unto the end, that ye may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

- **Responsibility For Those Belonging To GOD**

John 17:5-10 (KJV) 5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was. 6 I have **manifested** thy name unto the men which thou **gavest** me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word. 7 Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee. 8 For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me. 9 I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine. 10 And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them.

**manifested** - g5319. φανερώω phaneroō; - render apparent, to make known by teaching  
from g5318. φανερός phaneros – shining  
from g5316. φαίνω phainō - to lighten (shine)

**gavest** - g1325. δίδωμι didōmi - minister, number, offer, have power, put, receive, set, shew, smite (+ with the hand), strike (+ with the palm of the hand)

Hebrews 7:25-26 (KJV) 25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

26 For such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens

- **Opposition Happens at the Open Door**

1 Corinthians 16:9 (KJV) 9 For a great door and **effectual** is opened unto me, and there are many **adversaries**.

**effectual** - g1756. ἐνεργής energēs; from 1722 and 2041; active, operative: — effectual, powerful.

**adversaries** - g0480. ἀντίκειμαι antikeimai; - from 473 and 2749; to lie opposite, i.e. be adverse (figuratively, repugnant) to: — adversary, be contrary, oppose.

- **Travailing for the People**

Galatians 4:18-19 (KJV) 18 But it is good to be zealously affected always in a good thing, and not only when I am present with you. 19 My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you,

- **An Utterance of God**

Colossians 4:2-4 (KJV) 2 **Continue** in **prayer**, and watch in the same with thanksgiving; 3 Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of **utterance**, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds: 4 That I may make it **manifest**, as I ought to speak.

**continue** - g4342. προσκαρτερέω proskartereō; from 4314 and 2594; to be earnest towards, i.e. (to a thing) to persevere, be constantly diligent  
**From g2594. καρτερέω kartereō; from a derivative of 2904 (transposed); to be strong**  
**From g2904. κράτος kratos; perhaps a primary word; vigor (“great”) (literally or figuratively): — dominion, might(-ily), power, strength.**

**prayer** - g4335. προσευχή proseuchē;  
**from - g4336. προσεύχομαι proseuchomai; from 4314 and 2172; to pray to God, i.e. supplicate, worship**

**utterance** - g3056. λόγος logos;  
**from g3004. λέγω legō; a primary verb; properly, to “lay” forth**

**manifest** - g5319. φανερώ phaneroō; from 5318; to render apparent  
**from g5318. φανερός phaneros; from 5316; shining**  
**from g5316. φαίνω phainō; prolongation for the base of 5457; to lighten (shine)**

- **Witness to an End Time Work**

Matthew 24:14 (KJV) 14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a **witness** unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

**witness** - g3142. μαρτύριον martyrion

**From** - g3144. μάρτυς martys; of uncertain affinity; a witness (literally (judicially) or figuratively (genitive case)); by analogy, a “martyr”: — martyr, record, witness.
