Isaiah 28: 9 Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts. 10 For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little: 11 For with stammering **lips** and another (*aher*) tongue will he speak to this people. 12 To whom he said, This is the rest wherewith ye may cause the weary to rest; and this is the refreshing: yet they would not hear.

May there be an anointing to break it loose from the comfort zone of the milk of the Word. May God grant His perfect strategy in help us to lead from one level of spiritual maturity and development to the next.

Isaiah

Isaiah 6:5 Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean (*tame*) **lips**, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean (*tame*) **lips**: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts. 6 Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: 7 And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy **lips**; and thine iniquity (*awon*) is taken away, and thy sin purged.

Daniel

Daniel 10: 14 Now I am come to make thee understand what shall befall thy people in the latter days: for yet the vision is for many days. 15 And when he had spoken such words unto me, I set my face toward the ground, and I became dumb. 16 And, behold, one like the similitude of the sons of men touched my **lips**: then I opened my mouth, and spake, and said unto him that stood before me, O my lord, by the vision my sorrows are turned upon me, and I have retained no strength.

*We ask for the efficacy of an angelic touch upon our lips, commissioned by the heavenly Father, to break free from the tame and iniquitous. May we be empowered as intercessors to embrace a similar inspiration as was granted to Isaiah and Daniel. May the saints partner with the angelic host to proclaim the glory of our God.
