**Rev 10:6** And sware by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, **that** (because) **there should be time no longer:**

**Time – chronos- KJV** Of uncertain derivation; a space of *time* or *interval*; by extension an individual *opportunity*; by implication *delay*: - + years old, season, space, (X often-) time (-s), (a) while.

**L.U.L.:** "Gr. word translated as "time," "**season**" or "space" in the NT, meaning the overall timetable in the purpose of God. *Chronos* represents a season of time, or a measure of time covering a specific span. *There is a Chronos room or dimension within the Oracle that is located somewhere in the connection between the Third Heaven and the place of the Sons. There are angels of timing that seem to serve as guardians over the Chronos room."*

**Revelations 8:1** And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of **half an hour**.

**Revelations 6:10** And they cried with a loud voice, saying, **How long**, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? **:11** And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest **yet for a little season**, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they *were*, should be fulfilled.

**H3117** Di' yôm *yome* From an unused root meaning **to be hot; a day (as the warm hours)**, whether literally (from sunrise to sunset, or from one sunset to the next), or figuratively (a space of time defined by an associated term), (often used adverbially): - **age**, + always, + chronicles, continually (-ance), daily, ([birth-], each, to) day, (now a, two) days (agone), + **elder**, X end, + evening, + (for) ever (-lasting, -more), X **full, life, as (so) long as (. . . live)**, (even) now, + **old**, + **outlived**, + **perpetually, presently, + remaineth**, X **required, season, X since, space, then, (process of) time**, + **as at other times**, + **in trouble, weather, (as) when, (a, the, within a) while (that)**, X **whole (+ age), (full) year (-ly)**, + **younger**
