

## Fitly Joined Together

Song of Solomon 2:10-15 *The one I love calls to me: **Arise, my dearest. Hurry, my darling. Come away with me! I have come as you have asked to draw you to my heart and lead you out. For now is the time, my beautiful one. 11 The season has changed, the bondage of your barren winter has ended, and the season of hiding is over and gone. The rains have soaked the earth 12 and left it bright with blossoming flowers. The season for singing and pruning the vines has arrived. I hear the cooing of doves in our land, filling the air with songs to awaken you and guide you forth. 13 Can you not discern this new day of destiny breaking forth around you? The early signs of my purposes and plans are bursting forth. The budding vines of new life are now blooming everywhere. The fragrance of their flowers whispers, "There is change in the air." Arise, my love, my beautiful companion, and run with me to the higher place. For now is the time to arise and come away with me. 14 For you are my dove, hidden in the split-open rock. It was I who took you and hid you up high in the secret stairway of the sky. Let me see your radiant face and hear your sweet voice. How beautiful your eyes of worship and lovely your voice in prayer. 15 You must catch the troubling foxes, those sly little foxes that hinder our relationship. For they raid our budding vineyard of love to ruin what I've planted within you. Will you catch them and remove them for me? We will do it together.***

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### First Saturday Directive

A significant understanding of what was divinely directed in Isaiah 22:12 is found in how God presented Himself. He released the command as Adonai Yahweh Saba. Quite literally, God said "**I have created you uniquely and specifically to align with my eternal plan. You serve as trusted sons in conjunction with the angelic armies.**"

As Saints, God has asked all of us to do whatever we must to awaken ourselves to this understanding, and to align with this *eternal* identity. God has turned the page of His eternal plan, and the spirit realm is reacting to the change. Nations are being shaken.

Isaiah 22:12 *And in that day did the Lord GOD of hosts call to weeping (baca), and to mourning, and to baldness, and to girding with sackcloth:*

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### **Little Foxes - Interferences/Hinderances**

*15 You must catch the **troubling** foxes, those sly little foxes that **hinder** our relationship. For they raid our budding vineyard of love to ruin what **I've planted within you**. Will you **catch them and remove them** for me? **We will do it together**.*

- root and stem damage

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### **Vision**

I saw solid white giant-sized jigsaw puzzle pieces suspended in the air and scattered. I was in the sanctuary, and the puzzle pieces were suspended above the platform and pulpit, and I watched as they began to be repositioned into the fitted place for which they had been fashioned and designed.

### **Covenant**

A term in the OT translated from the Heb. word *berit*, meaning to cut out, to inscribe, a league or confederacy. It stems from *bara*, meaning to create, cut down. God has cut out or parceled out for us a piece of land, a pathway, or identity. **If we will go and dwell in that, it is a covenant**. He creates something for us with which to partner with Him. We cannot carve out our own path when moving with the Ark of the Covenant. We can only do what God has carved out for us. **A covenant is where we accept the responsibility God has given us and He accepts His responsibility for His plan to come to pass. God will remember the covenant He has made with us, and He moves on the basis of it**. The word “beret” may have come from this term; if so, it is like a covering for our head. This is favor that He showcases in the spirit realm. We are identified by the clothing with which He adorns us. **We are marked by God to move and operate in the place that He has carved out for us.** (LUL)

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Ephesians 4:1 *I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk **worthy (axios)** of the vocation (klēsis - klay'-sis – from kaleo) wherewith ye are called (kaleō), ...*

### **Worthy**

A term in the NT translated from the Gr. word **axios**, meaning deserving, comparable and suitable. From this word, we gain our English words axiom, axis, axle and axe. The Gr. word means to **assume the responsibility of weightiness, or the assumption of the bulk of consequence**. A person who is found worthy is someone who **embraces the measure of ministry that God has ordained for them and who is willing to bear the burden and weight of it**. It stems from the root word **ago**, meaning to bring, lead or drive toward something. This adds to the meaning of worthy to include **someone who is willing to take the lead concerning something, while investing themselves to make sure it is completed**. This is why God is worthy. He has committed Himself to complete what He has begun here on earth. When the Lord Jesus fulfilled the will of the Heavenly Father by giving His life for the redemption of mankind, He was found worthy. We become worthy, as born-again sons, when we accept an unreserved pledge to the will of the Heavenly Father. (LUL)

*klēsis* – (klay'-sis) – from *kaleo* - a calling, calling to; a call, invitation

*kaleō* – invited

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Ephesians 4:4, 13, 15, 16 4 *[There is] one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; ... 13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: ... 15 But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, [even] Christ: 16 From whom the whole body **fitly joined together** (synarmologeō) and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.*

*synarmologeō* (soon-ar-mol-og-eh'-o) – meaning to be **joined closely**.

From *syn* (soon) – a preposition denoting union; and is a derivative of a compound of: *harmos* – meaning a joining and *legō*.

Ephesians 2:21-22 *In whom all the building **fitly framed together** groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord: 22 In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit.*

1 Peter 2:5 *Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.*

**Chosen**

A term in the OT translated from the Heb. word *bachar*, meaning to try, select, elect or decide. It means to take a keen look at, to prove. Fasting that is chosen by God is for the purpose of developing us, changing us, and addressing our iniquities. In ancient societies, it meant for a specialist in a field to choose the absolute best for what he has to do. **God knows exactly what He wants to accomplish and the fast that He has chosen is to prepare us for this task. We offer our seed of submission in meekness for God to adjust us in any way that is necessary.**
