g0573. ἀπλοῦς haplou - Folded together

g4120. πλέκω plekō; - to plait, braid, weave together.

Matthew 6: 20-23

(KJV) 20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: 21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. 22 The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be **single**, thy whole body shall be full of light. 23 But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!

Luke 11: 34-36

(KJV) 34 The light of the body is the eye: therefore when thine eye is **single**, thy whole body also is full of light; but when thine eye is evil, thy body also is full of darkness. 35 Take heed therefore that the light which is in thee be not darkness. 36 If thy whole body therefore be full of light, having no part dark, the whole shall be full of light, as when the bright shining of a candle doth give thee light.

h8138. נָפַשׁ šânâ - to fold, i.e. duplicate

2 Kings 2: 9

(KJV) 9 And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a **double** portion of thy spirit be upon me.

g1362. διπλοῦς diplous - "double" and "twofold" in the NT, meaning an investment of some kind, whether good or bad.

1 Timothy 5:17

(KJV) 17 Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of **double** honour, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine.

Three-Fold

h8027. שְׁלֹשָׁה šâlāš - speaks of restoration in portions, strands, days or years

Ecc 4:9-12

(KJV) 9 Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. 10 For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up. 11 Again, if two lie together, then they have heat: but how can one be warm alone? 12 And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a **threefold** cord is not quickly broken

(KJV) 1 And the LORD said unto Aaron, Thou and thy sons and thy father's house with thee shall bear the iniquity of the sanctuary: and thou and thy sons with thee shall bear the iniquity of your priesthood. 2 And thy brethren also of the tribe of Levi, the tribe of thy father, bring thou with thee, that they may be joined unto thee, and minister unto thee: but thou and thy sons with thee shall minister before the tabernacle of witness
